



Dear Mr. Grant:

Am enclosing herewith map of Lovelock Quadrangle showing location of my Hartley Hope group of six claims, two others originally staked No. 5 and No. 3 had to be dropped this July since I was unable to do the work on them. They are open for staking and can be added in again if desirable as possibly should be for tunnel site and possible ore content. Many veins showing.

If it were possible for you to go over that way and look at them on your way East to Colorado, I could go with you and show you a great deal of very interesting things about that country between there and Scossa.

Otherwise I am not sure that I will be able to go at all, since unless I can find some immediate employment, my days for "staying with" the mining profession may enforcedly, be numbered - at least for the present. However, I want to leave no stone unturned to the end that some degree of successful results may come from the several years of hard and sincere effort.

Have dotted a line on the map from Jungo, Nevada (to and through Saw Tooth) to the plateau atop Box Canyon.

If you come onto the plateau from the Saw Tooth side, you proceed along the plateau road until just before (about 100 yards) it starts dipping sharply down into the wash on the Box Canyon side.

You can leave your car there and walk about a mile due East and come the edge of the escarpment whereon the Hartley Hope Group of Claims is located. Or if you are venturesome you can safely (aside from scratching your auto) drive through the sage brush right onto the claims over practically flat ground, as I used to do often two years ago. Doubt if my wheel ruts show now.

There are so many attractive prospects in that vicinity that I surely wish you could look them over with me. I'll be here at this address for the rest of this week anyway, and then I'm not sure. Funds getting very low.
