GEOLOGY: Locally quartz veins in place and as float in alluvium cover older meta sediments of Triassic age. Dozer cuts used to uncover quartz veins and to determine the extent of the veins. Sample 2801 from several different veins just south of the cabins. The material is a vuggy, iron-stained and some what broken quartz.

Mine workings in local drainages in this area are sunk to bed rock or clay lenses testing for placer gold.
