GEOLOGY: Site is pegmatite dike with massive quartz veins, perthitic feldspars, graphic granite, books and rosettes of muscovite, which trends N20W, appears to be vertical, ranging from 5-10 feet wide. The dike is surrounded by granitic gneiss, PG, quartz-biotite rich, Fe-Mn oxide stained. The dike is traceable for at least 200 feet north and south of site. The rocks are coated with a green alteration mineral. The books of muscovite grade into biotite and other mafic micas.
