DEVELOPMENT: Several vertical and inclined shafts, with prospect pits and trenches spread over several acres.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, but road newly graded, however, could be county or city maintained since there are homes in the area.

GEOLOGY: Workings collared in brecciated andesite dikes which show propylitic and argillic alteration. The breccia has abundant open spacing and is cemented with drusy and cockscorn quartz. Oxidized sulfides are found within the cavities of the breccia. The workings follow a N30W, Steeply NE dipping shear zone. The dikes are surrounded by dioritic gneiss (P6).
