ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Workings following calcite/quartz cemented brecciated andesite porphyry, with abundant Fe-Mn oxide staining. Workings were caved and no structure was apparent. The porphyry was argillically and propylitically altered. Cockscomb quartz filled open spaces in breccia, and by the weight of some of the breccia, suspect minor amount of barite was also integrated in vein. Quartz veinlets cut across host rocks.
