GEOLOGY: Workings are collarred in alluvium so structure not apparent. The dump is composed of andesite porphyry cut with quartz veins and brecciated. The dump is oxidized with abundant FeOx staining. Also in the breccia are fragments which appear to be chert. The rocks are silicified and porphyritically altered. Much of the mafics are gone. There are abundant open spaces in the breccia. Opaline crystals coat exposed surfaces.
