DEVELOPMENT: Series of shafts, adits, over several thousand feet, The main shaft, Shoshone, is 625 feet, with water at the 240 foot level.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: The owners are currently milling the tailings .47 Au/ton and 3 oz Ag/Ton Plan to reactivate mine, pending financing.
