ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: All of the workings along the range are in Auld Ang Sang Formation of Triassic-Jurassic age. The biggest in this part of the district is the Sugar Loaf properties which have a very large adit along a contact zone and vein system. Sample 2824 was from the big adit which has used rock bolts to support the ceiling in near vertically dipping sediments that bear S20°E. The sample consisted of vein material from within the the ait about 75 feet from the portal and from the dump. The mineralization includes sulfides as well as contact material.
