DEVELOPMENT: Six to eight benches cut in Triassic sediments. One dozer cut follows the northside of the eastern drainage for a quarter on a mile.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The benches and dozer-cut were made to expose tungsten bearing quartz veins. One of the bigger benches in the middle of the workings has exposed six veins varying in thickness to 18". The veins strike N40-60E and some are along shears. The country rx is a shaly member of sediments and is badly fractured. Sample 2938 is a composite of the veins and includes some sulfides.
