DEVELOPMENT: Dozer work on ridge south of canyon, drill holes along vein trend, caved adit at creek level.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Massive, white chalcedonic quartz veins which occur near the boundary of a rhyolite dike or plug and granodiorite. Granodiorite is highly FeOx stained and kaolinized at the contact. Quartz displays cockscomb structure, areas of quartz after calcite. Massive vein 2'-3' wide, at sample site 1487, trends N5°E, dips 60°E, vein in on one wall of 100'-150' wide dike of rhyolite, white quartz parallel walls of dike, some fine-grained pyrite in bands in quartz.
