GEOLOGY: The workings are in limestone of the Pogonip Group. They follow north  
bearing shear zone that is iron-stained and silicified as well as adjacent  
veinlets near the contact zone. Sample 3125 was from the dump and vein of  
the upper workings and consisted of lead-silver mineralization. The lower  
larger crosscut had no mineralization on the dumps and apparently did not  
incounter the ore vein??
