The 4 Ben Pasch claims are located in the Bloody Run district about 25 miles northwest of Winnemucca. The property originally belonged to Rudolph Winkle who attempted to mine complex silver-antimony ores from quartz veins occurring in granite.

Item 8

In the vicinity of the mine workings the country rock is limestone which has been intruded by a stock of granodiorite. Scheelite mineralization is confined to a quartz vein on the limestone granodiorite contact and in a quartz vein cutting the granodiorite. A shipment of 5 tons was made from the east vein on the limestone granodiorite contact that averaged 0.48 percent  $WO_3$ . Samples taken from development openings on the east and west veins ranged from 0.31 to 13.2 percent  $WO_3$ . Only assessment work has been done on the property since 1944.
