30 tons of ore sorted on dump assayed 5% Pb, 5 oz. Ag.

History and production 30 tons shipped in 1916. Ore shipped barely paid expenses.

Type Deposit (Geology) Rocks in vicinity comprise limestones interbedded with shale, strike N. 45 E., dip 35 NW. In the southeast area, 6 shallow pits and a 20-foot shaft explore a highly silicious iron stained outcrop gossany material carry small amounts of silver and lead.

Mine Workings In the north area 2 verticle shafts and 100 foot verticle shaft explore a crushed zone of limestone over a length of about 50 feet. The crushed zone strikes N. 10 E. and dips 75 W. and is 4 to 5 feet wide. Small amounts of lead and silver occurs with limonite.
