DEVELOPMENT: Old prospect pits & shafts along strike of shear zone.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: N80°W, 85°SW fissure-shear zone in limestone, heavy gossan along zone, gossa contains pods & kernels galena, cerrussite, Cuox. Intrusive crops out in wash north of sample site 267 (at 268). Intrusive is moderately kaolinized, FeOx-stained quartz porphyry. To the west two old shafts & connecting adit explore a parallel (or same) N60°-70°W shear zone, limestone bedding N20°W, 20°NE dip, massive chunks of galena found on dump.
