DEVELOPMENT: Three deep shafts in poor repair, bad roads and unusable surface structures. Several adits that are caved near their entrances.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Three shafts on the SW side of Mineral Ridge, Photo #9. Locally the geology is thin bedded siltstone and limestone of the Wyman Formation (Lower Cambrian), which is intruded by great masses of quartz, sometimes as pods or veins, crosscutting and intruding along bedding planes. Large masses of quartz are cropping out along the sides of the hills and the ridges. The Wyman is slightly metamorphosed with mica schist predominate. The sediments are highly deformed-faulted and folded. Mineralization is within the quartz veins. Gold is apparently associated with both galena and pyrite or as free-gold which is very fine. I was able to find some mineralization in the dumps by hand cobbing selected samples. Sample #1135.
