On May 10, 1941, Evans and Taylor, accompanied by Mr. Elmer Burt of Goldfield, examined a gold possibility in the Silver Peak District, 14 miles northwest of the town of Silver Peak, at Cow Camp. Detailed mapping applied to the mineralization, indicated a crescent shaped area of brecciation occurring in limestone. Values, if any, should occur in the quartz and calcite which cement the fragments. The property belongs to Mr. Jack Coughlin of Silver Peak, a county commissioner of Esmeralda Co. Assays on these samples were N.G.
