LOCATION

Silver Star Mining District, Mineral County, Nevada, about 12 miles northeast of Mina.

GEOLOGY

Areal geology consists of upturned massive siliceous sediments, striking approximately east-west and dipping to the south at angles varying from 50 to 70°. This heavy-bedded carbonate series has been completely replaced by silica, but retains its original bedding characteristics and the exceedingly dense lime rock structure. One small quartz monzonite porphry dike is exposed at the surface and suggests that the entire area may be underlain by quartz monzonite, which accounts for the extreme silicification of the sediments. Traces of weak copper mineralization occur throughout the silicified area.

DEVELOPMENT

Development consists of numerous shallow surface cuts and one adit tunnel.
