DEVELOPMENT: A line of inclines prospects and adits

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: A line of 5 adits and a major adit along with prospects explore a 3-4 foot vein in an E-W shear, that dips 70-75N. Vein is in rhyolite that is highly altered and bleached along the contact. Small mill site, ore-bins and fallen buildings suggest an earlier active period and at least some production. The workings are not on maps nor have they been identified in the references for the area. Sample 2782 was selected from the exposed portions of the vein and dumps..the silicified material showed some pyrite and minor brecciation in a quartz matrix .. vein was hosted in highly bleached and argillic gouge. Sample 2783 was selected from the dumps associated with the adit which cross-cuts the major vein system beneath the upper inclines and shaft.
