LOCATION

Silverton Mining District, Nye County, Nevada, 82 miles westerly from Ely, Nevada.

GEOLOGY

Silver mineralization occurs at the contact between a limestone bed and a rhyolite sill. Silver values occur mostly as cerargyrite as a film in fractures and coating particles of siliceous limestone, indicating secondary concentration. Some vein quartz developed at contact which carries finely disseminated silver sulphide. No silver values in this favorable limestone bed have been found more than a few feet away from the rhyolite contact. Continuity of oreshoot in doubt.

DEVELOPMENT

Open cut, 10 feet deep, and incline shaft reaching a depth of 30 feet.

Ore reserves negligible.
