GEOLOGY: A N10°E adit in highly altered and iron stained quartzite explores several shafts with drifts and cross-cuts very near the contact between the quartzite and the limestone.

Another N20°W adit 600 feet north in volcanics near limestone contact 3/4 of a mile north of the main shaft.
