ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Area consists of low rolling hills covered with random dog holes and dozer cuts, flags for possibly Geochem sampling. Most of workings at least 10 years old. Gweena Mine prospect is at least 6 vertical shafts, totalling probably 1000 feet, and innumerable dog holes. These look as if they were assessment work. The main shafts are along a trend N25W. Since the workings are in alluvium. No outcrop exists however, dumps are silicified rocks (shaley), Vinini Fm(?), some oxidization seems to be following highly fractured, crystalline, sulfide and Cu bearing quartz vein.
