GEOLOGY: Site has at least 3 shafts with innumerable prospect pits in area. Working several pits alluvium along trend N10W. No apparent outcrop however, dumps composed of what appeared to be Valmy Formation and massive white quartz vein material with specks of galena, and pyrite ghosts, minerals FeOx staining on fracture.
