GEOLOGY: Fractured, mod. kaolinized, FeOx-stained rhyolite breccia, rock is cemented with vein quartz, some veins up to 3"-4" thick, hill appears to be somewhat of a quartz stockworks, brecciated rock stained with hematite, limonite, vuggy quartz vein, wider veins have open centers, some bladed quartz-after-calcite pseudomorphs. Area of brecciation appear to include most of the small round hill (7082 mark at summit on Quad sheet) Possibly a rhyolite plug.
