History and production From 1917 to 1921 this mine produced 1,600 tons of crude ore. Ten tons of 60% antimony were recorded in 1938 and 30 tons of 12.7% ore in 1940. Three tons of 55 ore were produced in 1942. Property has been idle since 1942.

Type Deposit (Goeolgy) Two veins about 300 feet apart have been developed. They are roughly parallel and strike N. 10 W. and dip in seams and small bunches. Possibilities of developing new ore bodies do not appear favorable.

Mine Workings Approximately 1,500 feet of underground workings in adits, drifts and raise comprise the mine workings.
