LOCATION

In Humboldt range, 10 miles south of Inlay, Pershing County, Nevada.

GEOLOGY

The mine occupies an area of silicified rhyolite flows, tuffs and breccia that have been down faulted against schists, limestones and shales. Ore containing copper, gold and silver as tetrahedrite occurs in a sheared zone near the contact with the metamorphic sedimentaries.

DEVELOPMENT

The main workings have been through an adit 250 feet long driven on the vein. This connects with a shaft 75 feet below the surface, the shaft having been extended 100 feet below the adit level. Little is known of the area below the adit as water stands at the 40 foot mark. The ore shoot is about 50 feet long and about 6 feet wide, and appears to have a flat rake north in the vein. Values average about .08 oz. au, 11.0 oz. ag, and 1.3% cu. The gangue is hard, compact, silicified rhyolite. No estimates of reserves.
