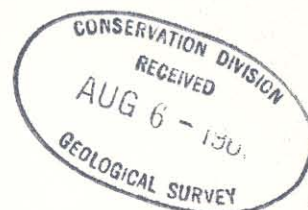

Summary and Recommendations:

Guild Nos. 2 & 3 placer mining claims are null and void ab initio by Executive Order 5389 of July 7, 1930, which withdrew, from settlement, location, sale, or entry, lands containing hot springs or spring waters of which possess curative properties (R.S. 2478; 43 U.S.C. 1201; 43 CFR 2321.1-2(a)).

Introduction:

The purpose of this report is to determine the validity of mining claims involved on the subject lands in order to further process Hot Springs Lease Application Nev-053878.

Two active steam wells were found on the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 33 and a steam bath or hot mineral water resort lies to the north and adjoining this 40 acre parcel.

During a field examination of the property, buildings and mining development work was found. These improvements were erected by other than the subject claimant.

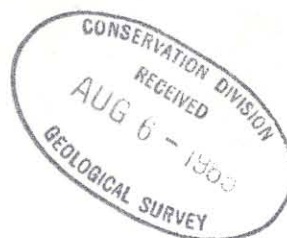

Conclusion and Recommendations:

It is concluded the subject land lies within the purview of Executive Order 5389 and the Guild Nos. 2 & 3 placer mining claims are invalid from inception.

It is, therefore, recommended the mining claims be declared null and void ab initio and allow further processing of the lease application.
