GEOLOGY: "A very large dump on NW side of Stonewall Mt marks the location of an adit that is reported to be over one mile long. The adit was driven in the 1915 to intercept silver veins in a shaft sunk from above. The adit is currently open to several hundred feet with numerous cave-ins. A pipe from the entrance is flowing sufficiently to provide drinking water to a small band of horses....Rocks on dump are largely limestone with considerable quartzite and CaCO₃ veins; including some skarn materials containing garnet, epidote, and some sulfides. Only activity is recent staking mentioned above." Jack's notes.
