DEVELOPMENT: Several locked adits, surface cuts, housing for ore trucks, overprints of several stages of production.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Currently active. Several new trucks & new rail system on site, appears to be in early production/development stage.

GEOLOGY: Host rock brownish-grey massive dolomite, highly fractured, and sheared, finely disseminated oxidized pyrite in limestone/calcite breccia, drilled above workings, formation appears to be dipping south, however, outcrops so fractured unable to determine true attitudes. At junction of jeep trail shown on map, beds, dip vertical to S70E limestone/with interbeds of sandstone and quartzite. Sample taken from stockpile at mouth of canyon no ore remains on dump, mainly consists of grey dolomite with barite/calcite veins, barite pods, minor Fe-Cu oxide stains.
