DEVELOPMENT: Originally one shaft(?). Within last two years a whole series of roads, open cuts & drill sites (at least 2 dozen) have been layed out. Work extends for at least a mile continued below.....\*\*

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None. Has been with in past year however.

GEOLOGY: All work confined to what looks like an up faulted block of highly silicified & Fe stained limestone. There are a series of approximately 6 silicified limestone knobs forming a ridge & flat area out from main mountain front. Limestone is highly fractured & silicified. Numerous quartz veinlets & considerable Fe oxide. Fe gossan-developed in a few places.
