ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None & hasn't been for some time.

GEOLOGY: Medium to dark gray phyllitic shale thinly to coarsely laminated, heavily Fe stained & cut with small quartz veinlets. Shale also cut by granitic dikes altho couldn't see these dikes in place you could see fragments here & there. Quartz is greasy dark gray & milky white. Thought that mineralization is associated with quartz veins-veinlets & granitic dikes.
