DEVELOPMENT: Heap leach facility at the bottom or mouth of the canyon

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Heap leach facility is not in operation nor is there any mining at this time

GEOLOGY: The country rocks are badly broken shaley sediments of the Raspberry formation of Triassic age, that have been intruded locally by what looks like a rhyolite breccia. Locally the breccia trends N10W and has minor crystal rich veins and veinlets associated with it. From a NE trending adit the mine workings have been stoped through to the surface along the strike of a vein at least four times in a distance of 300 feet. Much of the material removed from these workings have are now in the heap leach at the bottom of the canyon. Sample 2948 was chipped from the exposed vein in the adit along with silicified portions of the rhyolite breccia.
