GEOLOGY: Shaft sunk in alluvium. Outcropping rocks in area quartz monzonite (Sylvania Pluton, Tertiary-Jurassic), and garnet-epidote skarn, small pocket-like, remnants of roof pediment (?) Dump composed of gossany tactite, some which are cut with fine stringers of quartz, ^{Pendants} some have purplish cast (amethyst?). Abundant copper stains, secondary silica appears to have flooded the system. Rocks oxidized, bleached, slightly magnetic (magnetite? pyrrhotite?). Large calcite crystals in tactite.
