DEVELOPMENT: Western workings: trench, adit, surface cuts, eastern workings: shaft, surface cuts, drill pad, old and new workings appear to be exploratory

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Area has recently had extensive surface exploration, drilled

GEOLOGY: Workings explore a due E-W striking, north dipping fault zone, 3-6 feet wide, filled with brecciated quartz vein, fragments which have been milled, and is cemented with hematite stained silica. Fault/quartz vein cuts argillically altered clay/mudstone of PG Wyman Formation. Sediments are also cut by E-W trending aplitic/granitic dikes. Sediments locally hornfelsic. Also observed in float were tactite, banded phyllite/schist, shale
