DEVELOPMENT: Good road between the Landmark and Life Presever Group. A prospect-pit.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: The area is covered by rhyolite flows and tuffs of Miocene age. Cornwall, 1972.
The prospect is a small incline and pit along a brecciated zone which has been recemented by very hard cherty quartz. The vein maybe part of a fault contact which bears N 40 E, and dips 70SE. Pyrite ghost and dark streaks occur in a massive grey/white vein of quartz and quartz and quartz breccia(Sample #1909).
