The face of D 1006 is now at about coordinate 1910E-1260S. A quartz vein about one foot in width lying in the Montana Breccia has been followed during the week. Two assays taken during the latter part of the week gave \$12.52 and \$14.33 respectively, so there is evidently a little improvement in the value of the vein. Report on Mizpah Extension Lease for the week
ending April 2nd, 1917:

Crosscut 1302 having made connection with the Halifax 1200 Level at coordinate 1510S-3140E, and no veins of any sort having been encountered in this crosscut, all tools and equipment were removed from this part of the mine and work started on the 1000 Level at coordinate 1280S-1930E.

The old crosscut terminating at this point was turned to the northeast, and during the week holed through to the face of the old drift on the contact which shows at this point and carries considerable quartz. After cross-cutting the hanging wall a short distance to determine the width of the contact zone and the character of the formations, drifting to the north will be resumed at the most likely looking place.

This particular place was chosen for starting development work for the reason that there is quartz to follow, and that work can be done here cheaper than at any other place in the mine. In your letter of February 7th, you suggested cross-cutting north on the 1160 Level, but both crosscuts on this level are in lower rhyolite, and both at a considerable distance from the shaft, so it was finally decided to start work on the 1000 Level, rather than the 1160 Level, and await your next visit to the property, when we can very easily start work at any other place which you may suggest, if you think the work on the 1000 Level is not going to be of any benefit to us. This new work, as I mentioned before, is on quartz, and it seems that the chance for developing a little ore are as good, if not better, than in the crosscuts below, which are in the barren lower rhyolite.

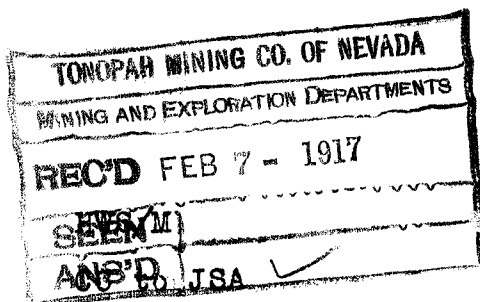

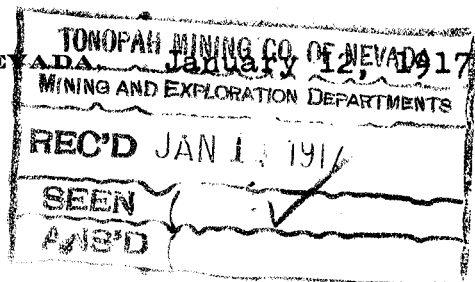

I have your letter of January 8th, in which you state that the option on the Mizpah Extension has been extended for another year, and that you wish to have the expenditures reduced to a minimum.

The only work being done at present, as you are aware, is in the south cross-cut on the 1345 level, which is being driven toward the Halifax 1200 Level and still has about 200 feet to go in order to make a connection. It costs more to do work at this point than at any other place in the mine, requiring seven men to get in one round per day, as I mentioned in my weekly letter of January 9th. This is the best we can do and get around in the face each day, but by cutting off two of the men we could get in a round every other day. If the idea is to do just enough work to hold the option, this plan might be satisfactory, but would result in very little progress being made. As the 200 feet which this cross-cut still has to go will be in Trachyte, I would suggest that the connection with the Halifax be made before quitting work on the 1345 Level.

The most economical place at which work could be done would be on the 1000 level, but it is doubtful whether any benefit would be derived from development work done on this level. The only place I could suggest would be on the Oddie Rhyolite - West End Rhyolite contact, at coordinate 1260S-1960E, where there is still a little quartz showing on the contact. A north drift on this contact could be advanced at the rate of a round every other day by three men, and would also require a minimum amount of power and supplies.

We will continue work as at present until I hear from you regarding what changes you would like to have made, or whether you have any places in mind where you would suggest starting development work other than the one I have mentioned. It would also be a help if you would state the minimum amount we are required to spend each month under our new option.

I have just been through the Mizpah Extension workings.

I am sorry to say the recent developments in this property have not yielded favorable results. The new level has developed a floor of Lower Rhyolite, which cuts off our drifts on this level on the west and north. Our east drift is in the trachyte, but we should encounter the overlying Later (Midway) andesite almost any day now. Our greatest amount of trachyte lies to the south, and I today started a cross-cut south, discontinuing the north cross-cut (in lower rhyolite). Except for this work there is little work left to do in the present workings, which would have sufficient chances of success for me to recommend.

The Mizpah Extension has a large undeveloped acreage to the east, which is of considerable possible future value; but any scheme of further development would in my opinion be too extensive and expensive to warrant undertaking at present. I do not think the property would warrant more than a minimum expenditure,

sufficient to keep it alive, with the possibility that future developments by our neighbors might make⁴ resumption of more active work advisable. The Halifax is working out in that country, and are further east than we, and the Belmont is diamond-drilling still further east, and all this development is to our advantage.

Acting on this, I have instructed Stotesbury to cut down work from two shifts to one, effective December 1st. This will cut down expenses for December from about \$3500., (for October) to \$2300.

As to the amount required for a minimum expenditure, for just keeping the mine alive, Stotesbury makes an estimate of \$1500., a month, which of course includes prosecuting development work, but at a minimum pace. That would amount to \$18,000., a year, and I think it would be worth that much to secure and hold this acreage.

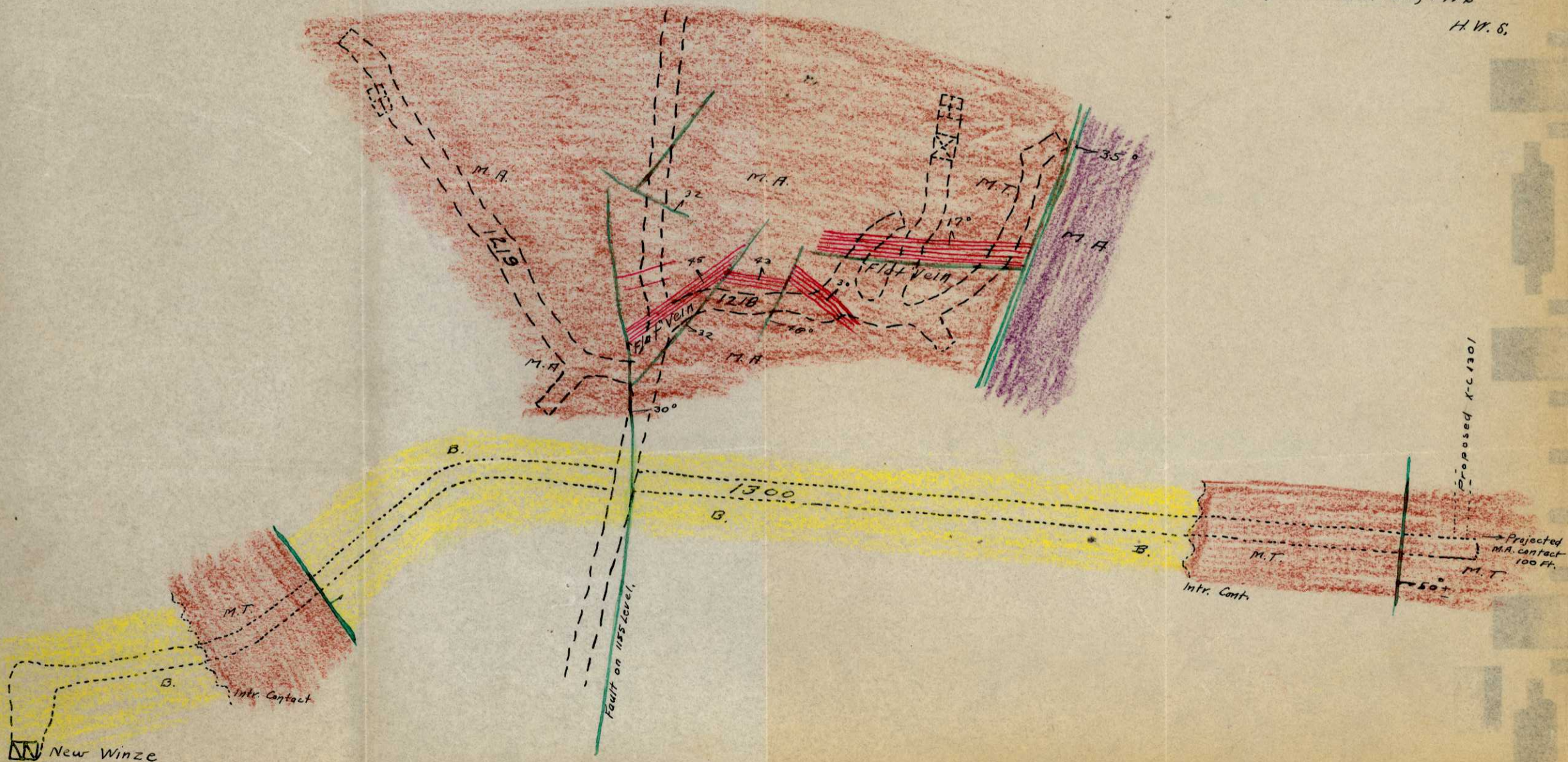

Stopping operations have failed to disclose any ore of better value than was encountered in the drifts on the vein, and it has been found that the hanging wall of the vein is of such a nature as to require a great amount of timber to keep the stopes open. The stoping has been done at various points on the vein, so that the average values obtained are fairly representative of the average value of the vein as developed, and it seems that this value is too low to warrant mining the ore under the present conditions.

To August 1st the total charges against stoping amounted to \$1741.23, and the net return from the ore shipped was \$1809.59, a profit of \$67.36. However, there was no charge made against stoping for the proportion of power used in breaking and hoisting the ore, and it is evident that if

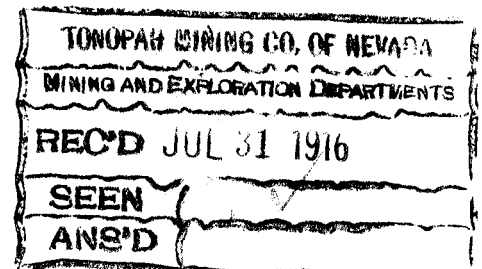

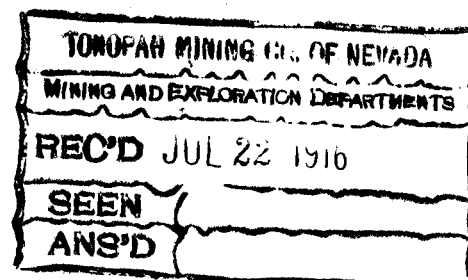

1155 LEVEL:

X-C 1200 north from the old winze is being straightened, and air pipe, track and ventilating pipe are being installed. This work will be completed in a few more shifts, when cross-cutting north will be started from the face.

1345 LEVEL:

The station is now completed and cross-cutting east will be started. A raise will also be driven from the bottom of the winze to connect with the station, and will be used as an ore and waste pocket.

GENERAL

The work of re-timbering the shaft for a distance of 250 feet above the 400 foot level will be started tomorrow (July 18th) and all other work will be discontinued while this is being done. Three shifts will be employed, and it is thought that it will not take longer than three weeks to complete the work.

The ore in the flat vein is now all very low grade, and unless a little improvement is soon shown it will probably soon be necessary to discontinue stopping operations.

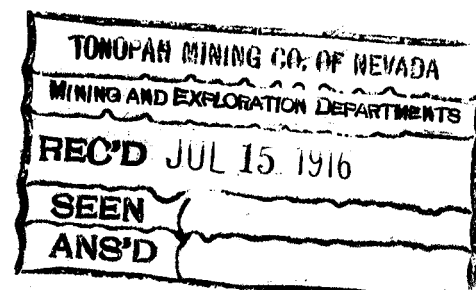

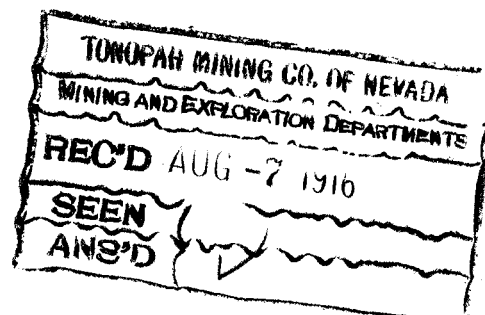
