





This particular place was chosen for starting development work for the reason that there is quartz to follow, and that work can be done here cheaper than at any other place in the mine. 

I have your letter of January 8th, in which you state that the option on the Mizpah Extension has been extended for another year, and that you wish to have the expenditures reduced to a minimum.

The only work being done at present, as you are aware, is in the south cross-cut on the 1345 level, which is being driven toward the Halifax 1200 Level and still has about 200 feet to go in order to make a connection. It costs more to do work at this point than at any other place in the mine, requiring seven men to get in one round per day, as I mentioned in my weekly letter of January 9th. This is the best we can do and get around in the face each day, but by cutting off two of the men we could get in a round every other day. If the idea is to do just enough work to hold the option, this plan might be satisfactory, but would result in very little progress being made. As the 200 feet which this cross-cut still has to go will be in Trachyte, I would suggest that the connection with the Halifax be made before quitting work on the 1345 Level.

The most economical place at which work could be done would be on the 1000 level, but it is doubtful whether any benefit would be derived from development work done on this level. The only place I could suggest would be on the Oddie Rhyolite - West End Rhyolite contact, at coordinate 1260S-1960E, where there is still a little quartz showing on the contact. A north drift on this contact could be advanced at the rate of a round every other day by three men, and would also require a minimum amount of power and supplies.

We will continue work as at present until I hear from you regarding what changes you would like to have made, or whether you have any places in mind where you would suggest starting development work other than the one I have mentioned. It would also be a help if you would state the minimum amount we are required to spend each month under our new option.

The flat fault showing in XC-1300 last week was intersected by a steeper one striking about north and south and pitching to the east at an angle of about 45-50°. The formation on the hanging wall (east) side of the fault is Mizpah Trachyte.

The face of this crosscut is now over 500 feet from the winze and working conditions are very poor in spite of the forced ventilation. The temperature at the face is 93° F., with a relative humidity of 84% and it is becoming very difficult to find men to work under these conditions. We have been working two shifts per day in this face, but during the past two or three weeks several shifts have been lost due to the inability of the men on one shift to get the drift cleaned out in time for the following shift to work.

It is thought that we can better conditions somewhat by starting a north crosscut from the present face (1100 S. 3070 E.) and also continuing to drift to the east, and drilling one round each day in each face, in place of the present method of drilling two rounds in one face each day. This will give the machine men the advantage of a clean "set-up" and will allow more time for ventilation between rounds.
