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INTRODUCTION

Houston International Minerals Corporation bought out Hughes Tool Co./Summa Corporation holdings in Tonopah, Nevada, in 1977, acquiring among other properties the offices headquartered in the office building in Tonopah which for many years was the headquarters of the West End Consolidated Mining Company. In the attic and vaults of the office were records of West End and related companies from the beginning of the Tonopah and its' mining industry.

Hughes Tool Company/Summa, predecessor of Houston International, used the records and papers and especially the maps in the conduct of business in Nevada. Houston International, funding them of historical as well as business value, has had them collected, arranged, and cataloged in the finding aid. The work was done in Tonopah in the old West End office building.

The collection consists of about 7500 records and 1700 maps, the geology, minerology, and mining of the area; also claim, ownership, and administrative records of mining districts, public utilities and governing bodies, but chiefly of the mines and mining companies created, acquired or absorbed by the West End Consolidated Mining Company of Tonopah.

The original silver discovery in Tonopah was in 1900. The city was formed immediately, and early records are in the collection. The West End claim was one of the first half dozen, and is centrally located in spite of the name. The company formed by the owners in 1906, through lease, litigation or purchase soon became one of the leading producers of silver, and an economic power in Tonopah.

After the peak years of production in Tonopah, 1912-14, many companies disappeared, by 1930 only West End was a large company. In the succeeding years production was chiefly by lease, and the entire town suffered from depression. Both bonanza and decline are apparent in the records. So is the pattern of change in engineering, labor, business, and social patterns.

A entire new era in the mining and mineral production was recorded when West End was purchased by the Hughes Tool Co. in 1967.

Several chronology charts have been included as part of this introduction to facilitate use of the collection.

The scope of the collection is limited to the geographical area of Tonopah, Nevada; the years roughly to 1905 to 1975, and the subject to mining and mineral production and the means of conducting a mining business.

The papers are arranged in two records groups - documents and maps. The series in both groups consist of general area records, followed by mining company and mine records, West End Consolidated Company records, the records of one specific mine, The Mabel. One records series is the ledgers of the West End Company. The final series are the Hughes Tool Company papers. Subseries consist of mining company, mine, function, or person.

The entire collection is available on micro film through Houston International Mineral Corporation, Carson City, Nevada. The original collection is to be found at the Central Nevada Historical Society, Museum, Tonopah, Nevada.
