PARCEL NO. 1 - ALPINE GROUP TONOPAH MINING DISTRICT

This group covers 18 unpatented mining claims situated in the Tonopah Mining District, and located about one and one half miles Northeast of the town of Tonopah. The group adjoins the Mizpah Extension Company of Tonopah and the Halifax Tonopah Mining Company, which lie Southwest of the Alpine Group. Both of these properties produced ore, with the Halifax having the larger production. The Alpine Group is within one half mile of the Tonopah Belmont Development Company group, which produced over \$30,000,000.00.

A bulletin compiled by Thomas N. Nolan, U.S. Geological Survey, dated September 1, 1935, under the caption "The Underground Geology of the Tonopah Mining District, Nevada", covers the vein structures of the various properties in Tonopah proper. In closing this report he comments as follows:

"A much more speculative possibility is the exploration of the region a few miles North of Tonopah. The origin of the faults and the ore bodies as outlined in the preceding pages is thought to be connected with a localized uplift in the footwall of the Halifax fault zone. It seems logical to assume that in other places along the Halifax zone there may have been similar uplifts, which also may be mineralized. Unfortunately the region to the North, which for several reasons is believed to be more favorable, is largely covered by younger rocks, so that direct surface examination for signs of local uplift of minearalization is not possible, and the large area involved would make the cost of adequate surface exploration, either by drilling or by shaft sinking, much to great. It is possible that detailed instrumental mapping of the few scattered outcrops of the pre-mineral in formations might in turn could be explored by drilling."

The mine operators in the Tonopah District at the time of the completion of the Nolan report, apparently disregarded his theory as no work was undertaken by any of these companies to explore the region he mentioned. The Nolan report was compiled in 1935. In 1965, or thereabouts, diamond drilling was undertaken by outside people and this work was done in the area

known as the King-Tonopah Mining Company, North of Tonopah, where a 300 foot shaft had been sunk by Tom Lynch and William O'Meara in the early days of Tonopah. The drilling encountered ore at a reported depth of 800 feet. Work was then done by a company consisting of repairs to the 300 foot shaft and then cross cutting North from the bottom of the shaft where a commercial ore body was found and mined on the level and in some places above and below the level, but no workings reached the depth of 800 feet where ore had been found in the original drilling. In all these mining operations work was done on short capital by several parties. The group production of these operations resulted in about \$250,000.00 worth of ore shipped.

This work clearly demonstrated the existence of another parallel vain system to the original veins in the Tonopah area proper. Values and character of ore mined also is the same as the Tonopah area. However, in this section North of Tonopah the ore body developed there rises closer to the surface. In most of the Tonopah mines it was necessary to sink 600 to 800 feet through capping that covered the ore deposits.

The Alpine Group lies to the East of the King Tonopah property, in line with the strike of the new ore body in that property and it is logical to assume that this vein system can extend into the Alpine Group on its East-West strike.

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

GEOLÓGIC REPORT OF THE TONOPAL-BELLMONT MINE.

Introduction:

The Fonepah-Belmont mine is located in the Bighorn hountains of arisona, which is about twenty-five miles southwest of wickenburg, a station on the Santa Fe Ry., and a like distance nortwest of Palo Verde on the Southern Pacific Ry. from which point the ore and concentrates were shipped to lexas.

The mine was discovered in 1904 and was subsequently named the Belmont-Mc Neal. The early day record of production and work is not available now. In the years 1926 to 1930 the mine was operated by a group of nevada miners who renamed it the Ionopah-Belmont Mine. It is asserted on good authority, which seems logical, that the mine closed down because of low metal prices at the beginning of the Depression. Copper sold for 8¢, lead for 4¢, silver for 26¢ per ou. and gold for 5 20.86. It has not been operated seriously since then. A 60 ton bulk flotation plant was built to beneficiate the ore, but a mine only 400 feet deep must be within the oxide zone at this location. It is obvious then that copper values would hardly be recovered because of its tendency to oxidize readily.

as stated the mine is 400 feet deep below the present adit level, however this fact wannot be verified now because the lowest accessable level is the 300. It is also stated that the one was faulted off below the 400, and if this is true, there should be no difficulty in relocating it by present core drilling methods. The two present levels, the adit and the 300, have been surveyed by me using the Brunton Compass. The points exterior to the mine were surveyed by a standard and accurate transit and tied to the underground survey to correlate the data in plan.

My observation on the surface had indicated that there were two intersecting vein systems each containing at least two vein-fractures. One trends northeasterly and the other trends souteasterly. The southerly vein of the first system intersects the westerly vein of the second system to form expanded and large ore-shoots at their intersection. The fractures containing the veins of both systems are easily identified because they are filled with friction-breccia.

I am prepared to show that other ore-shoots can be expected at the intersection of the southerly vein of the first system with the easterly vein of the second system. This are has not been drilled or otherwise been prospected although it is only 125 feet from the eastern workings on the 300, where the exposed vein is known to continue eastward. I shall also indicate that the ore continues downward under the present ore-shoots into the sulfide zone.

Topography:

The area surrounding the mine is typical semi-desert country, abounding in cacti but containin no desiduous trees. It lies in an old mid-tertiary lake bed out of which drownd mountain ranges arise. The latter are not over 1,000 feet above the lake beds in elevation, therefore the dirt roads leading to the mine are generally level and good until the mount ins are reached. Even here the gradient is low and toward the shipping points, bater exists in the washes at a depth about 700 feet below the present add level. This is presumed to be the present ground water level based on wells of the area.

Stratigraphy and Petrography.

The immediate area of the line untwins no recent i.e. post-cambrian sedimentary rocks. It is an area of precambrian schists, measses and granites introded by tertiary angesites, latite permitties, casalts flows. There is good reason to beleave that granitic monitorites underlie this area also.

matic and approximately 90% feet square. Its intrusive nature is indicated by its nealy vertical and fluted wails that simulate a volunt clug. This has been forced up through the surrounding schist and old granites which had been covered by an old basalt flow. The remants of the latter can be seen on the steep slopes of the ring. This election movement was no doubt part of a greater regional thrust, because the premineral fractures containing breccia extend at least a mile to the west, and the second system is said to a far to the southeast. Both of these transect the plug, but in the outer reaches of the fractures and perhaps in the plug itself they are in part inied by the latite perphyry. There is definite evidence that the mineralizing solutions came up the sides of these dikes and into the breccia, partly filling it and partly replacing it to form the present ore hodies.

Veins:

The veins, filling the fractures are about 300 feet long and average four feet thick before the intersection is entered, at the latter point the erepipe is roughly 30 feet wide and of varying length. The northeasterly vein dips south at an eighty degree angle. The rake is eastward or vertical. The southeasterly vein has a vertical dip and rakes northward. The shoots now indicate that they were mined from the surface to the presant 300 foot level below the acit. This height is a maximum of 500 feet. It is at once obvious that the lower portions of these veins are still is the oxidized zone, and it is unusual in arizona me to find a vein as large as either of these to end or bottom at this depth. It is presumed for this reason as well as the fact that this mine has not been diamond. drilled to our knowledge, that the sulfide ore will be found below the present ore-shoots, as stated previously there is also the intersection of the northeasterly vein with the velons parallel fracture which can easily be seen on the surface. The latter can be shown to be heavily mineralized at one point, where copper ore has been uncovered, just east of the plug at the surface. This fracture is also brecciated. Future prospecting:

The two good possibilities for discovering new one can be made by the use of the diamond drill. One to three boies at least 150 feet deep must be drilled norizontally to intersect to intersect to itersection of the two veins to the east. This would prove or disprove this premise of another large one-shoot. These are best drilled from the present 300 foot level below the adit. The other premise is that of the underlying primary suffide zone. This can be drilled from the 300 or the cleaned out 400 or from the surface. From the 400 foot level the drill holes should reach down at least 200 feet. Five holes should be planned. From the 300 these holes would be 300 feet deep. The surface holes would have to be about 500 feet deep. The first case east of the 300 and at the intersection of the veins may also be drilled from the outside but the depth of the holes have not been computed. This same intersection may be found by drifting eastward 125 feet on this level.

Ore shipments and sampling:

The ore concentrates in the past were shipped to bl haso, lexas. This is a lead smelter and would not pay for copper from this bulk frotation. Obviously much of the latter went into the tails because of its oxidised nature. These tails were later recovered during the last war by leasers. Nothing remains from these tailings, between the years of 1926 to 1930 the following record is available on production: Copper-700,000 its; lead-5,000,000 lbs.; gold-5 210,000.00; silver-\$ 120,000.00.

On april 2 1957 two miners were instructed to take samples on the 300 foot level. In veiw of the difficulty and danger of getting down the present shaft I did not wittness the sampling. I presume the samples are better than average, so I discarded the two high readings for copper and the three high readings for lead. Jold and silver cannot be seen or identified as such in the ore and are therefore taken at face value. The cor-

Dear Mr. Steen:

It was a pleasant surprise to hear from you so many years after I had worked in Tonopah. Although I've driven through a few times, I've pretty much lost touch with the people I knew back in 1929 and 1930.

I am still working full time for the Geological Survey, though I gave up the administrative work several years ago in order to devote more time to my own geologic work. This is concentrated in the area around Eureka--not too many miles from Tonopah.

I had heard that Hughes had taken over many of the properties in Tonopah-and had a rather short talk last summer about the district with Peter Joralemon, who I believe may have been doing some geologic work for the Hughes company. It's been so long since I worked at Tonopah that I'm not sure that I could really offer any very good advice to Mr. Anderson. And in any event, since I'm still employed by the Geological Survey, it wouldn't be possible for me to undertake any private work for the company.

If Mr. Anderson, or one of his associates, were to be in Washington, I'd be very happy to talk to them about the district. One item that might be of interest and which is on open file here, is my set of 200' = 1" geologic maps of the underground workings. I suspect they are probably the most complete set of district maps still in existence; I know that we made tape and compass maps for many workings that weren't shown on the maps we found in the company offices.

I hope to be in Eureka for the Survey from early June until the end of August, so Mr. Anderson might want to look me up there.

Curiously, after receiving your letter last week, Mrs. Nolan and I had a visit during the weekend with Ian Campbell, whom you may remember as being with us both years we were in Tonopah. He remembers you, of course--and mentioned that he had heard rather recently from Cecil Chiatowch and his wife--whom we had known as Mrs. Selma Tolscott's daughter.


