Dear Joe:

We represent the Tonopah Extension Mines, Inc. and I am writing to you because I understand that you have handled most of Howard Hughes' mining transactions in the Tonopah area.

I am sure that you are generally familiar with the fact that the Tonopah Extension was for many years one of the major producers in the Tonopah Mining District. It owned a number of patented and unpatented mining claims located generally between the Lambertucci property and Tonopah. As you come into Tonopah from the north, the huge steel headframe of the Victor Shaft still stands out as one of the outstanding landmarks of the area and is located a few hundred yards to the east of the highway.

In any case, the Company sold its properties to a man named Paul Watterson in 1962 for \$750,000 subject to a deed of trust on the property which was security for a promissory note in the amount of \$745,000. This note, however, has been in default for many years, but instead of foreclosing, the Company endeavored to give Watterson's successor in interest an opportunity to satisfy the obligation. Incidentally, the present owner of the property, who acquired it from Watterson, is the unsuccessful bidder for the Lambertucci property - Sierra LaPlata Mining Company.

Since it appeared to the Company that Sierra LaPlata was not in a position to pay the amount due on the note, the Company concluded that its only alternative was to instruct the trustee to file a notice of default. This was done and the notice was recorded in both Esmeralda and Nye counties on November 18, 1969. The amount of the principal still due and unpaid is

Joseph Foley, Esq. -2-January 20, 1970 \$663,949.57, together with advancements in the amount of \$46,372.39. After the expiration of the statutory three months' period, the trustee will of course have to publish the notice of sale for a three week period, so that the sale will not be held until some time after March 11th. Judging by past performance, I seriously doubt whether Sierra LaPlata will be able to come up with the amount of money necessary to pay the obligation to Tonopah Extension. Frankly, my purpose in writing to you is to find out whether or not the Hughes interests might be interested in acquiring this mining property. If so, we would certainly provide any and all information, data, maps, etc., that we have to you, or to your engineers and geologists for appropriate examination.
