
There was no evidence of location notices, or any indications of the party that had done the flagging.

These were over and on the Tonopah King Extensions No. A, B, C and D. The order of the first named was reversed on the T.K.E. claims A, B, C and D.

Mr. Anderson asked me to go to the court house (Nye County) and find out if there were any recordings for these claims. I did not find anything recorded as of that time.
