Parcel 1: 19 claims in the Tonopah Mining District in Esmeralda County, Nevada. These claims lie about 3000 feet Westerly from the Lambertucci claims.

Parcel 2: Jumbo Extension Mine in the Goldfield Mining District in Esmeralda County. This property is adjacent to the Duffy-Davis property and is in the mineralized belt in Sec. 36; T2S; R43E.

Parcel 3: 21 claims called the Linda Group in the Goldfield Mining District. This area is in Sec. 8; T3S; R43E, and is about 3 miles Easterly from Goldfield, Nevada.

Parcel 4: 400 claims in the Goldfield Mining District - roughly embracing parts of Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 in T3S; R43E, a couple of miles Easterly from Goldfield, Nevada.

Parcel 5: 34 claims in the Weepah area, Esmeralda County, Nevada.

Parcel 6: A group of claims, number unknown, several miles South of Silver Peak, Esmeralda County, Nevada at Birch Creek.

Report: Mr. Burkett submits some history and geological reports of some of the areas as well as some assay reports. Together it makes a sizeable report.

None of the property offered by Mr. Burkett is adjacent to any of the Hughes Tool Company claims. However, in some districts Hughes Tool Company has claims near by.

It might be well to have Mr. E.L. Stephenson review the reports on the claims, especially in the Goldfield District and make a preliminary report as to their probable worth to Hughes Tool Company.

Mr. Burkett does not mention any price or terms. However, he and his partner are anxious to make an appointment and discuss the property.

often local, and consequently it is possible to obtain specimens of fresh and altered rock within moderate distances of each other. The two specimens of dacite analyzed and compared were taken about  $1\frac{1}{4}$  miles (2 kilometers) apart.

The fresh dacite has been fully described on pages 55-58.

FIGURE 19.—Diagram showing the portions of the Goldfield district in which the rocks have undergone extensive alunitic alteration.

The altered dacite, of which a chemical analysis by Mr. George Steiger is given under 2 (p. 181) was taken from the 230-foot level of the Combination mine, in a place to which oxidation had not extended. The original water level in this mine appears to have been at about 130 feet from the surface, near which depth the oxidized ore gives place to sulphides. The rock analyzed is the typical wall rock of this and adjacent mines.
