DEVELOPMENT: One adit about 100 feet long others more shallow, several stone cabins all near a large spring.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Largest workings are along a granite/limestone contact that bears N80°E, and appears to dip 60°-70°NW. The workings are old and primitive partly caved and short. The contact zone is silicified, broken and iron-stained. The silicified material was chipped from the contact and included; pyrite, galena and reported gold and silver. Sample 3103 was from the vein in the large adit, while Sample 3104 was from the dumps associated with the lower workings.
