DEVELOPMENT: Two adits on southside of canyon, two adits on northside..the longest of which is 180ft, others ore 50, 60 and 100 feet long.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The largest adit is on a 15 foot quartz vein that strikes S70°W and dips 50°NW. The vein is near the contact between a shaley limestone and a Quartz Monzonite of the Troy Peak Pluton. Some of the workings maybe hosted entirely within the monzonite. The ore-bodies were reported to be tabular in shape and where mined in flat stopes. The big adit was still accessible but most of the other workings were caved. Mineralization in Sample 3108 consisted of galena, sphalerite and silver bearing sulfides not identified. A road into the area within the last 5 years would seem to correspond to the staking of the Roweho Claims in 1983.
