GEOLOGY: The exact location of the leadhill claims are not confusing as is implied from the literature the workings are in an east west canyon along a contact zone about 1 mile south of the mouth of Troy Canyon. The contact is between limestone and granite with the mineralization associated the limestone as replacement ore. A number of the workings are collared in granite but lead into the limestone. The ore-bodies were flat lying, irregular pods. The ore is galena with yellow oxide coatings. There has not been any activity for many year and the work to-date is crude and primitive.
