The Millett Property consists of two claims, unsurveyed, in the Toyabe Range at Pablo Canyon, about twelve miles west of Round Mountain, Nye County, Nevada.

The claims cover the outcrop of several barren quartz veins having a north-south strike, and the only work done consists of two vertical shafts each about 30 ft. in depth, one on one of the quartz veins and the other in the hanging wall of the same vein. It is in this latter shaft that the pay ore has been discovered.

The country rock consists of quartzite and schist, and the ore deposit is a silver-lead ore occurring in a fissure of the quartzite. In the shaft where this ore is exposed the ore body shows on only one side of the shaft and is not continuous throughout the depth of the shaft, being divided into an upper and a lower portion which are separated by a few feet of soft country rock.

The shaft on the quartz vein was sunk a number of years ago, and examination and sampling (sample No. 29) prove the vein to be barren.

It is the desire of the owner (Mrs. Gertrude Millett) to secure reliable parties to develop the ground, and any reasonable terms would be acceptable.

Although the results of the sampling show the ore to be of a high grade character, it shows no signs of permanency, and the property is not recommended as a good prospect except for work on a very small scale.
