Just a few lines to let you know I have hired a licensed water rights surveyor Ernest E. Muller #273, who has been developing maps & surveys. He works in Carson for the Highway Dept. and I have known him for quite a few years. He has checked and is sending you information on two patented mining claims which I will give you below and if you can locate two of the Giant Claim Corners (patent corners) this will help and cut down on the length of survey if the Giant Claim is close and a part of your holdings. The Giant claim was patented on March 23, 1895 and is 600 feet wide and 913 feet long the 913 feet runs North and South. The corner posts were set in 1879. The main shaft & tunnel is about mid center of the Giant Claim. It was patented under survey #37 and post No 1 is the South East Corner; post #2 is the Southwest Corner; post No 3 is the North West Corner and post No 4 is the North East Corner. Hope you can find at least two of them and then draw a plat plan of the adjoining corporation owned claims and indicate where the 5 acre mill site is to be also where you want to pickup the water from the stream. We are enclosing maps etc. for you to hold until we arrive May 18 (Saturday). I will pick Ernest Muller the water rights surveyor up and bring him out with me and act as "Red Man" for him. We hope to do all of the ^{field} work Saturday, even if it takes until late Saturday evening, so anything you can locate for us will of course be helpful and save us time.

Mr Muller says there is also a patented Mining claim the "Wahlonga" patent #3984 Survey #411 which is approximately 1 mile East of the Giant. Also we are able to locate the old Mill site which shows on the water rights survey map of early days. As of now, from our records here in Carson the property appears to be in Twp. 14 N; Range 42 East; Sec 35 or Sec 36, (these are unsurveyed townships which makes it a little difficult) This is the reason to tie to at least two corners of the Giant patented claim if possible.

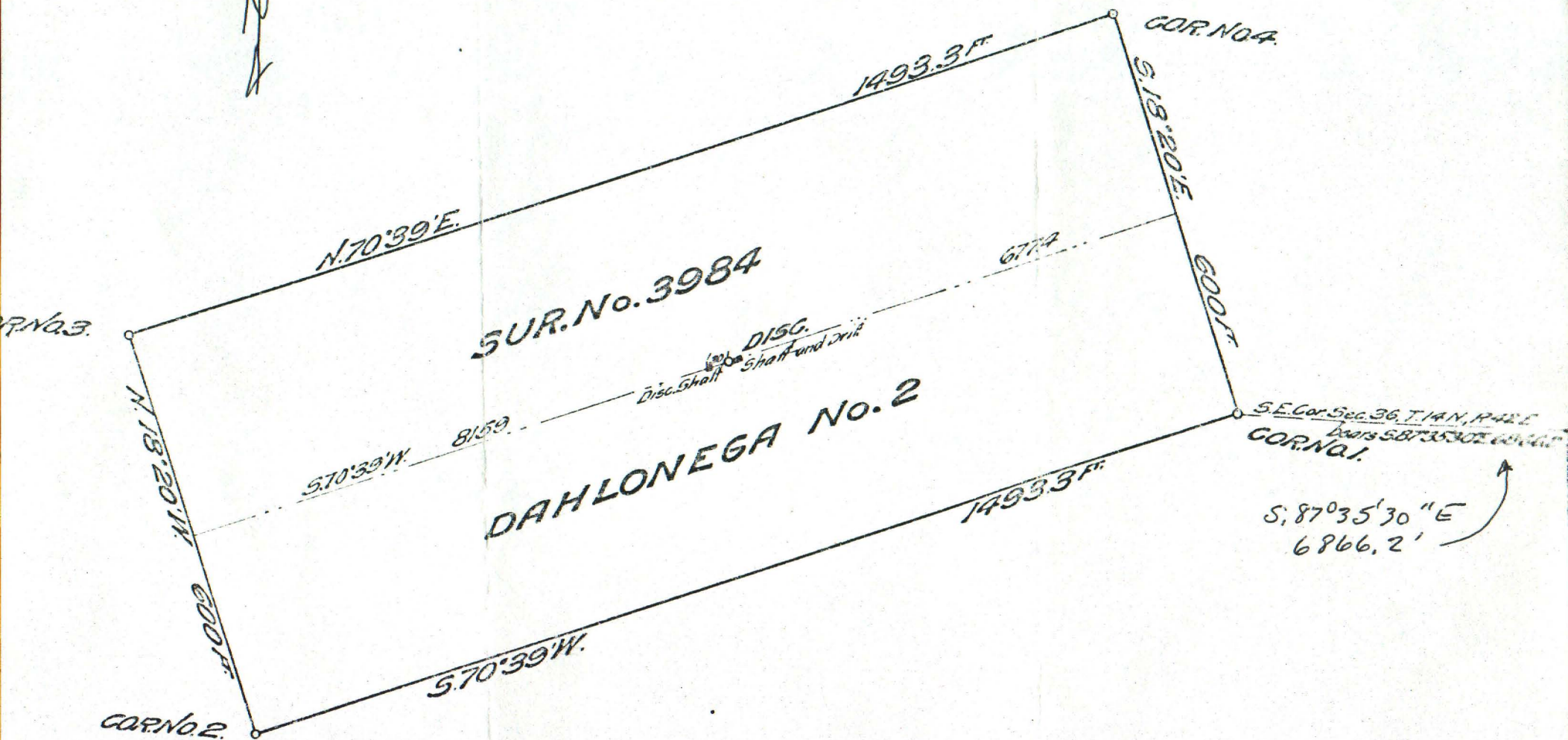

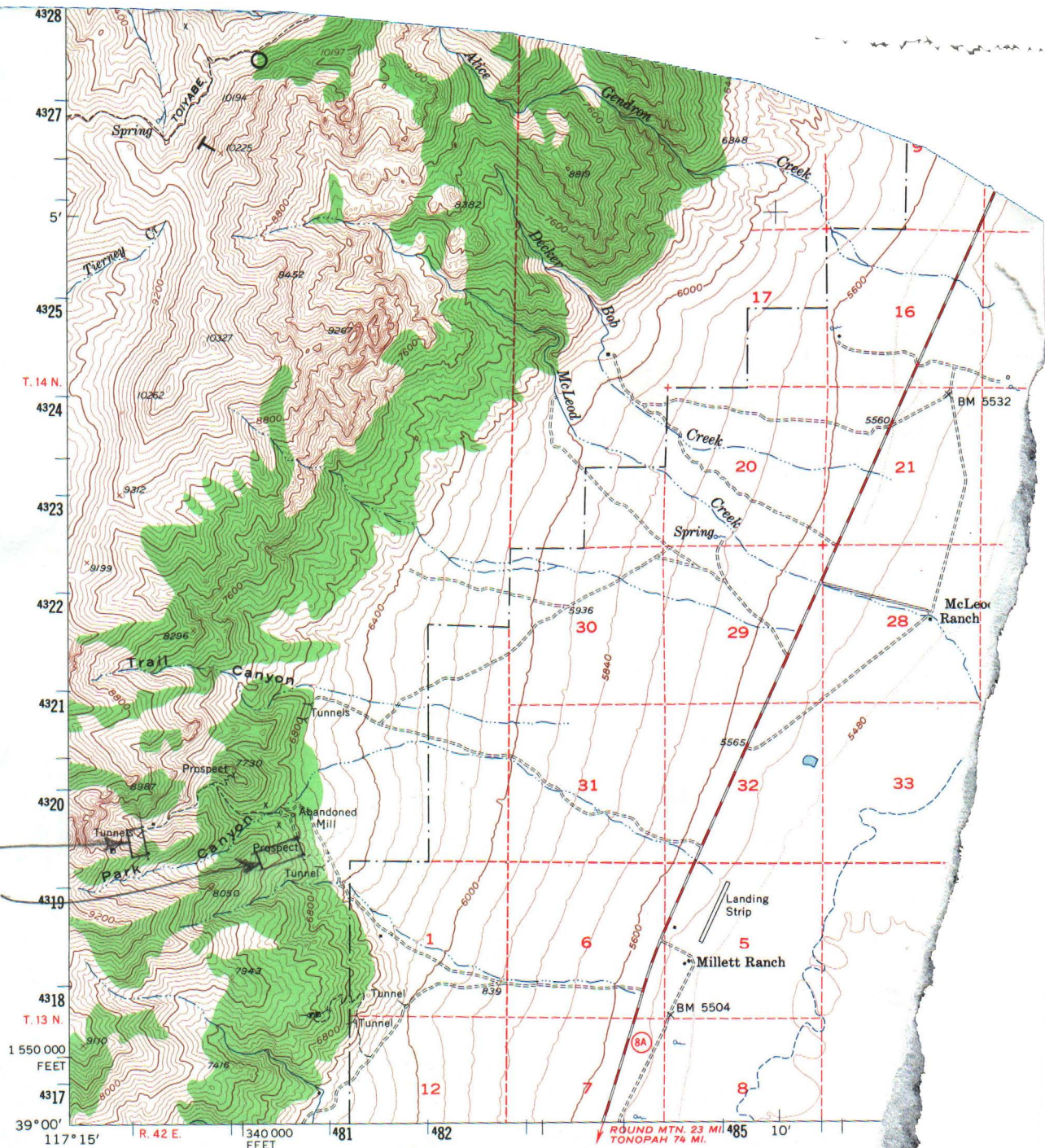

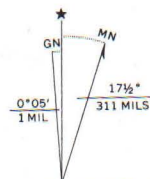

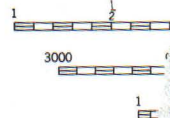

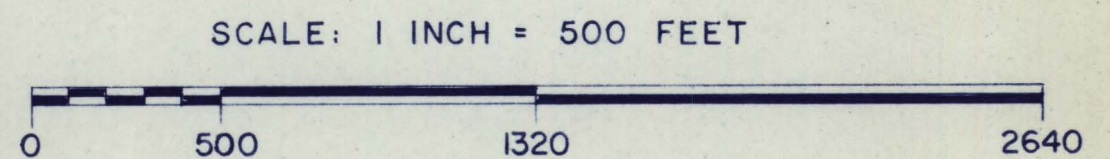
