DEVELOPMENT: Old shaft and adit several buildings and materials staked out.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Shaft sunk on N15°E, vertical vein. Workings are old but appear to be in good shape. The mines in this north trending canyon seem to be on a major structural system that may have acted as a conduit for ore solutions. At least seven different properties extend along the western margin of the range for a distance of about four miles and have a similar mineralogical assemblages. Sample 3089 was selected from dumps associated with a fairly large shaft. The vein material should strong hydrothermal alteration including iron-staining, manganese, some brecciation, copper oxides and possible tetrahedrite.
