DEVELOPMENT: Old shaft and headframe in usable state, some trenching and prospect pits further up the mountain.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Shaft was sunk on a N15°E, 55NW mangeses stained quartz vein that outcrops to the north of the shaft. Again the trend continues to the north in the limestone with mineralized quartz vein occuring in what appears to be a north-trending shear acting as a conduit. Sample 3090 was selected from the dumps associted with the shaft and consisting of minor copper oxides and possible tetrahedrite.
