DEVELOPMENT: Two caved adits, one open adit a stope or shaft(?), remnants of a log cabin with square nails.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Open upper adit bears N75E, 20 feet from portal adit bears east along a 2 foot shear in limestone and intersects with the stope. Sample 3093 is from the upper workings and consists of a highly silicified breccia with a dark gray matrix some of which is tetrahedrite and other sulfides. The sample was chipped from exposed portions of a vein and selected from dump. Some of the breccia was piled on the upper dump as though it were ment to be transported. Sample 3094 was from a dump near the partly caved lower adit approximately 100 feet below the upper workings and consisted of breccia and argillic vein gouge. The last material removed from the adit was a reddish-brown sandy sediment. The lower adit bears N75°E and is collared in limestone. The size of the workings are quite extensive and at 8200 feet they are 800 feet above the nearest road which is a half mile to the west near a mill site.
