DEVELOPMENT: A shaft and several adit one of which probably intersects the upper shaft.. several prospects and short adits.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Shaft and main lower adit on N55°W, 75NE vein in 4-6 foot shear in limestone. The vein is strongly oxidized with iron-staining and argillic gouge. Quartz and calcite occur as stringers. There is no road and only limited trails. Remnants of a cabin and a black smiths hearth are near one of the workings. A hand capstan put together with square nails is in place at the top of the timbered main shaft. Sample 3095 was selected from the dump near the shaft and chipped from the vein in the lower adit.
